New South Wales Cycling Federation Official Race Entry Form

Entries may be received by either:

- a) Online via the Cycling NSW race entry system
- b) POST with applicable cheque /money order to: Po Box 7209 Bass Hill NSW 2197

- d) Fax with Credit Card details to FAX: **02 97385853**
- e) All entries must be on an official Race Entry form and will not be accepted unless all details are included, signed and accompanied by the correct entry fee
- f) Entries will not be accepted by telephone
- g) Refer to your race calendar for the correct entry fee
- h) Multiple entries are encouraged
- i) Competitors must keep a personal record of events they have entered and their receipt confirmation if made online
- j) Competitors must report with their Racing License to collect their race number no later than 15 minutes before the advertised start time of an event
- k) Failure to return race number immediately following withdrawal from an event may incur a penalty
- l) All riders entering a sanctioned CNSW event agree to abide to the terms and conditions applicable to that event
- m) All riders entering an event do so acknowledging drug testing by the appropriate authorities may be undertaken at any sanctioned event
- n) All riders entering a sanctioned CNSW race event acknowledge that cycle racing can be considered a dangerous sport, and whilst all reasonable care is taken by the race organizers and officials when organizing an event, all participating cyclists have an equal responsibility to ensure they take all reasonable care by adhering to the rules and any other conditions imposed by Police and or officials ensuring a safe race environment for all concerned
- o) All riders entering a race event do so acknowledging any medical conditions or past medical history is not the responsibility of the organisers
- p) All riders entering an event confirm they have read and are familiar with CNSW's race rules as documented under Cycling NSW Technical Regulations (A copy of which is available on the CNSW website or by contacting the CNSW office)
